

Constitution of the National English Honor Society

Adopted 6 November 2004

Article VIII The Chapter Advisor

- Section 1** The chapter advisor shall be a member of the English faculty, appointed by the principal, and may serve consecutive terms.
- Section 2** The chapter advisor shall be responsible for the direct, day-to-day supervision of the chapter and act as liaison among students, faculty, administration, and community.
- Section 3** The chapter advisor shall maintain files on membership, chapter history, activities, financial transactions, and the chapter bylaws.
- Section 4** The chapter advisor shall regularly review each member for compliance with Society standards and obligations.
- Section 5** The chapter advisor shall help the chapter officers understand and carry out their duties.
- Section 6** The chapter advisor shall be a voting member of the Faculty Advisory Council.
- Section 7** The chapter advisor shall be designated a NEHS honorary member, but will not pay the national induction fee.
- Section 8** The chapter advisor shall be the major liaison between the local chapter and the National Office, submitting the membership information and fees, and any other items requested by the National Advisory Council, and receiving for prompt distribution those items, pertaining to membership, sent by the National Office.
